1. The publication on which the student is a member must have active MHSPA membership
2. The student must have served on staff for two years, including one year in an editorial position.
3. Verification of at least a 3.75 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale). This may include a letter from the school guidance counselor verifying the GPA, or copies of official school transcripts.
4. A publications adviser or journalism teacher must make a written recommendation and include the student's current position on publication.
5. A student may apply for Distinguished Journalist status, All-Minnesota Journalist status or All-Minnesota Editor, but only one of the three.
6. Submit all material and completed application by **May 8, 2009**.
